


## GFS - ideas and topics



You are interested in doing your GFS in English? Great!

Here are some ideas that might help you finding an interesting topic for your GFS.

Of course you can also find a different topic.

### ➔ **TOPICAL PRESENTATION**

You present a problem-oriented and limited aspect of a larger historical, political or social subject related to the English speaking world.

### ➔ **DISCUSSIONS / DEBATES**

You prepare and organize a discussion or a debate on a certain topic.

### ➔ **EXHIBITIONS / MUSEUMS / etc.**

You turn your classroom into a museum or a gallery. You are the tour guide and lead your visitors through your exhibition.

### ➔ **FILM ANALYSIS**

You compare two or more films that you've seen with each other. Instead of films you might as well deal with music and compare songs, etc.

### ➔ **PERFORMANCES**

You act out a role play or you stage a short play. Maybe you have even written the play yourself.

### ➔ **PROJECTS / SURVEYS / INTERVIEWS**

You want to do a certain project? OK. Why not present this project and its results?  
You would like to carry through a survey on a certain topic? Fine. So why not describe this work and present it as your GFS?

### ➔ **CREATIVE WRITING**

You have a real talent as a writer of short stories, special newspaper editions, a radio feature, a play, poems, etc.? Great. Why not do this as a GFS? However, keep in mind that you have to present your work somehow and that maybe your teacher will ask you to have a short colloquium concerning your work.

### ➔ **PLANNING AND TEACHING A LESSON**

You can teach a certain topic, a piece of literature, or maybe just a picture or a cartoon to your classmates. If you think you have a suitable topic, ask your teacher about it.

### ➔ **PREPARATION OF AN EXCURSION / STUDIENFAHRT / etc.**

If you are about to go on an excursion or something similar, why not prepare your class for this trip with an interesting GFS.

### ➔ **TALK / REPORT**

You have experienced something extraordinary and really interesting? There's a person that you really admire? You've been on fascinating journey?  
Maybe these topics could be interesting for your fellow students as well. Ask your teacher if it's possible to make a GFS presentation on the topic you have in mind.
